PRINCIPIA ORANGE 2020 LUNAR

This wine is made from the white grape Malvasía Castellana. It is fermented on its skin, hence the orange hue, the almond flower aromas on the nose, and the hint of peach in the mouth.

These bush vines, grown on decomposing granite soil from 1910 to 1950, are southwest and northwest facing. We only use around 10 to 20 milligrams of free sulfur.

SOIL TYPE

Various types of decomposed granite

PLANTATION DATE

1910, bush vines without irrigation

VINEMAKING

Hand-harvested, destalked, natural yeast for the alcoholic fermentation

AGEING

Half in 500-litre French oak barrels for one year, half in stainless steel

CHARACTERISTICS

Orange, natural, still, complex and mineral.

Alcohol - 13,5 %

Total sulphur - around 10 to 20 mg/litre
